Improve ecology of the hike and bike

Is it fair that much of the park is closed to the public during 4 months of the year? ...

...Provide nodes for programming (educational and recreational)...

The city's tree management along the main trails in Zilker and along Lady Bird Lake...

Update the playground area as a lot of this has become old and in needs of update...

Add some bathrooms..

Reclaim the landfill area along the lakelakeside picnic, trail opportunities...

Let's spend the money on shade and erosion control.

Add a Beer Garden located in along Lady Bird Lake near MoPac...

Could there be parking more on the periphery of the park & more shuttles on peak days...

...Fit another playscape (or two!)...

I think it is a terrible idea to reduce parking around Zilker Park.

We should prioritize and enhance the natural environment and address the increased usage of Zilker Park...

Reducing parking is very unfair to younger people who can't live nearby...

No vendors at all...

...Add 8 pickle ball...

Zilker needs to be more about parkland: Shared paths, open meadows, seating area, field areas for sports, innovative playscapes..

More green and less Concrete

Water taxis are a great idea if they don't present an ecology hazard..

Pedestrian safety would be immediately improved if parking was only available along the perimeter...

By increasing trees and reducing parking, the 'Rewilding' idea would convert Zilker into a neighborhood park...

The biggest issue I have with Zilker is the difficulty of getting there without a car...

...Families do not have to cross Barton Springs Road...

Need another dock for lake access to paddle board & kayak.

Please let's not increase traffic in Zilker...

Keep ACL fest at Zilker...

More rewilding, less commercial, no vendors, more shuttle...


